PROFILE

Aman currently works at Heart of England NHS Foundation Trust as clinical lead for the paediatric musculoskeletal service. This includes the provision and management of the physiotherapy service for the outpatient musculoskeletal service. This includes the completion of newborn hip ultra sound scans, as well as working closely with an Orthopaedic Consultant in a weekly outpatient clinic. She has a special interest in the treatment of children with clubfeet and hip dysplasia.

She also has experience in the neurodevelopmental assessment of new-borns and young infants, working with a variety of patients such as premature babies, children with cerebral palsy and gross motor development problems resulting from abnormal neurology or extreme prematurity.

Aman is also responsible for the teaching and education of under and post graduate therapists, doctors and nursing staff.

She has continued to attend courses and has received training in the assessment and management of children with neurodevelopmental conditions, congenital musculoskeletal abnormalities and older orthopaedic conditions.
